State funded scholarship schemes:-

- 1.) Reimbursement of Tuition fee for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category studying in class I to XII, studying in recognized public/private schools of Delhi.
- 2.) Merit scholarship for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category studying in class I to XII.
- 3.) Financial Assistance for purchase of stationery for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MIN. Category studying in Class I to XII.
- 4.) Merit scholarship for students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MIN. category studying in Professional/technical colleges/ Institutions/ Universities.

Centrally sponsored schemes sponsored by MOSJ&E, Govt. of India :-

- 1) Post Matric scholarship for SC students.
- 2) Pre matric scholarship for sc students.
- 3) Post Matric scholarship for OBC students.
- 4) PRE Matric scholarship for OBC students.

Guidelines of above mentioned eight scholarship scheme are available on the official website of the department i.e. www.scstwelfare.delhigovt.nic.in. In this connection, Department has already been published advertisement of these schemes in leading newspaper.

These schemes are required to be popularized among aspiring students of the under-privileged sections of society. The schemes may be circulated to all recognized education institutions through the administrative departments. Following steps may be taken for success for these schemes:

- 1) Setting up of help desk. Nodal officer may assist the eligible students to apply online.
- 2) Information may be prominently displayed on notice boards of educational institutes.
- 3) Students should be briefed about the scholarship schemes and their benefits, regularly, during the morning assembly.

You are therefore requested to issue necessary direction to the concerned schools/institutions/colleges to start the verification process of their respective students.
